

Legacy Co-op Travel Centre — Fact Sheet

At a glance

- Location: Corner of Highway 9 and Grain Millers Road, Yorkton, SK
- Hours: 24/7 self serve fuelling once open
- Site: Approximately 10 acres; 6,400 sq. ft. convenience store and truckers' lounge
- Investment: \$18.5 million
- Status: Approvals in progress; Traffic Impact Analysis complete (final report pending)

What it includes

- Fuel and DEF, showers, washrooms, laundry and a truckers' lounge (24Hr)
- Six high-flow diesel lanes with satellite pumps for heavy trucks
- Light-vehicle fuelling on both sides of the site to reduce congestion
- Parking for about 30 semis; separate area for about 15 RVs; sani-dump
- Hot food, deli sandwiches, salads, veggie trays, RO water and beverage selection
- Picnic area and off-leash dog park

Access and traffic flow

- New service road from Grain Millers Road to ease congestion at Highway 9
- Design separates heavy and light traffic for safety and speed
- Project will meet updated City of Yorkton bylaws related to truck stops

Who it serves

- Professional drivers (semis)
- RV and camper traffic
- Passenger vehicles and families
- · Local workers seeking quality food and beverages
- Highway travellers looking for a dependable stop

Timeline

- Groundbreaking targeted for 2026, subject to approvals
- Heavy-traffic and light-traffic fuelling and parking, and the Travel Centre built at the same time
- Opening planned for late 2026 or early 2027
